### Steps for Submitting Proposal for Transfer of students from Unviable Programmes

It is the responsibility of the institution which has decided not to offer unviable programmes to transfer the candidates allotted either within the institution or outside the institution. All such colleges shall therefore contact the candidates allotted on phone, take their preference and submit proposal for transfer on 02.03.2021 and 03.03.2021.

The programme will be continued and students will not be transferred.</b></li><li>• <b>If the institution does not desire to offer the programme, click on 'No' for the academic year 2020-21</b></li></ul>
02.03.2021 & 03.03.2021	<p><b>If 'No' is opted, the college will be given an option to submit proposal for transfer of students, either</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>to another programme within the college on 02.03.2021</b></li><li>or</li><li>• <b>to another programme in another Degree College on 03.03.2021</b></li></ul>
